

## County Commissioner District Search Instructions

- Select the link below

- Select the check box within the "maps disclaimer" area to continue to the search window
- Select "show/hide layers" link that appears in the upper right corner of the display
- Place a check mark next to the "Elections & Voting" item that is now displayed on the right side of the window
- Type your home address into the "Search Addresses" field located on the left side of the window. Do not enter the city and zip code

Example: 123 Elm Street

- Press the "Enter" key on your keyboard or select the "Search Addresses" button that appears beneath the field where you entered your address to commence the search

An identifier will now appear on the map to your right that provides your location. If there is only one address that matches your address, then this identifier will be the number "1". If multiple identifiers appear then you will need to select the appropriate one using your mouse pointer. You can use the "+" symbol that appears in the upper left section of the map to zoom closer to get a better view of the appropriate County Commissioner District that is displayed.

Alternatively, use the "zoom to" option to see an aerial image of your property. This image will also display the name of your county commissioner adjacent to the picture of your residence.
